Linguistic Immersion Course for International Students (A1 - B2)

ELE 20: modules from October 24 to May 25

Start: Monday October 1 2024 / **End:** Friday May 30 2025

Courses aimed at students who wish to initiate their knowledge of Spanish language and culture with a communicative approach adapted to the specifications of the Common European Framework of Reference for Language. This option has been designed for students who wish to make rapid progress in language acquisition and can attend class every day from Monday to Friday, 4 hours a day. In this course programme classes of language and culture outside the centre are included, taking advantage of the cultural possibilities of the city.

Conditions

Students must attend a minimum of 80 percent of the classes to receive a final attendance certificate, and then having passed the evaluations over the course, the attendance and course completion certificate. In this certificate, teaching hours and their distribution, along with the level achieved by the student will be stated.

The course modules in Spanish Linguistic Immersion for international students

- Include:
 - Spanish language and culture classes with ELE teachers qualified in Spanish Philology and solid training and experience in language teaching.
 - *Welcome pack* including the first student manual (*Aula Internacional Plus 1*, editorial Difusión).
 - Teaching materials and personalised tutorials.
 - Access to Valencia University's Online Classroom (developed on Moodle version 4.0).
 - Conversation workshops and linguistic tandems organised by the centre outside the class timetable.
 - *Outdoor* classes and linguistic challenges in the city of Valencia and its surroundings.
- Not included:
 - The following manuals according to the number of contracted modules.
 - Other voluntary activities, such as vocabulary and conversation workshops in museums, cinemas and theatres in the general cultural offer of the city, and organised by the Centre d'Idiomes for our students.

Matricula closing date

The Matriculation period will close on the first day each module begins.

Course cancelation

The carrying out of the above programme modules is dependent on the matriculation of a sufficient number of students established for each course. If the number of students doesn't reach the established minimum, the course may be cancelled. In the same way, the management reserves the right to cancel or divide the groups according to the needs of the centre. This situation will be communicated to the people affected, who will receive information as to other groups available or, should it be the case, the return of the amounts paid.

The cancellation of the course gives the students the right to apply for the return of the fee or to be transferred to another CdIUV course of the same, or inferior or greater value (either the student or CdIUV paying the difference respectively) within the same academic year, all this depending always on the availability of places and the fulfilment of the class requirements.

The motives for the cancelation of the course may be:

- a) Cancelation of the course when the minimum number of students hasn't been reached.
- b) Administrative error.
- c) Causes beyond our control.
- d) Changes in the timetable and/or of course dates on the part of the teaching staff.

Conditions and the right to cancelation

Before the course begins, with no need to give any motive, the student can exercise the right to cancel the contract within 14 days of the payment of the matriculation.

If this right to cancel should be exercised once the course has started, but still within 14 calendar days of the confirmation of the matriculation, the amount to be returned will be processed deducting the amount proportional to the part of the course attended from the start to the day when the cancelation was communicated.

How to carry out the cancelation

In order to carry out the cancelation, whatever the modality of the course may be, the student must notify his or her decision to cancel the contract in writing to the Secretary's Office at the Centre d'Idiomes.

To fulfil the time limit of the cancelation you only have to send the notification of the cancelation before the time limit has expired. The CdiUV will return all the payments received within 14 calendar days from the date of when the cancelation was sent for the student to withdraw from the contract. Any repayment of the cancelation will be carried out in the same method of payment as the initial transaction. In no way will the student will be charged any extra amount as a consequence of the cancelation.

Cancelation and leaving the course

Independently of the right to cancelation above, the repayment of amounts paid can be requested according to the following indications. The request should be carried out by email to the Secretary's Office at the CdiUV: contactocdi@uv.es

In general terms it has been established:

- If the student cannot start the module for reasons out of his or her control the student can request the return of the course fees up to two days before the start of the module.
- After the module classes have started a request for the repayment of the course fees will not be accepted.
