Language Immersion Course for International Students (B1 - B2 – C1)

ELE 20: modules from October 25 to June 26

Start: Monday 1st October 2025 / **End:** Friday 30th June 2026

Intensive course aimed at students who wish to begin their knowledge of the Spanish language and culture with a methodology based on the “learning by doing” model and classes adapted to the specifications of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. This option is designed for people who want to make faster progress in learning the language and can go to class every day from Monday to Friday for 4 hours a day. The course program includes language and culture classes outside the centre in different activities that take advantage of the city’s cultural events. In addition, project work, literature workshops and writing workshops are included in the course development.

The teaching calendar of the Centre d'Idiomes de la Universitat considers the calendar of the Universitat de València. Christmas, Fallas and Easter are considered holidays on the university campus and there will be no classes.

Conditions

Students must attend a minimum of 80% of the sessions in each level to receive a final certificate of attendance and, in case of passing the evaluation tests during the course, of attendance and achievement. The certificate will state the teaching hours, the distribution of those hours and the level reached by the students.

Compulsory exam for access to B1 level

To access B1 level, it is a requirement to pass the A2 level language skills test with at least 60% of the mark. If the student does not pass the A2 level exam, he/she will have to repeat the level and may be given new entry dates for level A1 and A2 depending on the course programme.

The modules of the Spanish Language Immersion course for International Students

- Included:
 - o Spanish language and culture classes with Spanish as a Foreign Language teachers with degrees in Hispanic Studies and with a solid training and experience in language teaching.
 - o Welcome pack that includes the first level Student's book (*Aula Internacional Plus B1*, editorial Difusión)
 - o Didactic materials and personalized tutorials.
 - o Access to the Virtual Classroom of the University of Valencia (developed with the Moodle version tool 4.0).

- Conversation workshops and language tandems organized by the centre outside of class hours.
- Creative writing workshops and project work. Literature sessions.
- Outdoor classes, and linguistic challenges in the city of Valencia and surroundings.
- Not included:
 - The second or subsequent books depending on the number of modules contracted.
 - Other voluntary subscription activities organized by the Centre that take advantage of the opportunities that the cultural events and the tourist character of the city offers.

Registration closing

Enrolment will close the first week of the start of each module or, earlier, when the maximum number of students enrolled in the available groups has been exceeded.

Cancellation of the course

Completion of the modules of this program is subject to the enrolment of a minimum number of students set in each one. If the number of students does not reach the minimum set, the course may be cancelled. It is also at the discretion of the Management to divide or cancel a group based on the needs of the Centre. This circumstance will be made known to the people affected, who will receive information from other available groups or, where appropriate, the full refund of the amounts paid.

The cancellation of a course entitles the enrolled students to request a refund of the registration fee or to be transferred to another course in the CdiUV of the same, lower, or higher amount (paying the user or the CdiUV the economic difference) within the same academic year, all this provided there are still available places, and the requirements of the new courses are met.

The reasons for cancellation are as follows:

- a) Cancellation of a course for not reaching the minimum number of students.
- b) Administrative error.
- c) Due to supervening force majeure.
- d) Change of schedule and / or dates by the teaching staff.

Conditions of the right of withdrawal

Before the start of the course, and without giving any the reason, the user may exercise their right to withdraw from the contract within a period of 14 calendar days from the date of payment of the enrolment fee.

If the right of withdrawal is exercised once the course has begun, but within a period of 14 calendar days from the date when the enrolment was formalised, the amount paid will

be refunded, discounting the proportional amount corresponding to the part of the course taken from the start date until the date when withdrawal is notified.

How to withdraw

To exercise their right of withdrawal, regardless of the type of course, the user must notify their decision to withdraw from the contract in writing to the Language Centre Secretary's Office.

To comply with the withdrawal period, it is sufficient to send notification of the exercise of withdrawal before the corresponding period expires. The Language Centre will return all payments received within a maximum period of 14 calendar days from the date on which the user notifies their decision to withdraw from the contract.

Any refund derived from the exercise of the right of withdrawal will be made using the same means of payment used by the user for the initial transaction. In any event, the user will not incur any costs because of repayment.

Cancellation and withdrawals

Regardless of the right of withdrawal, you may request a refund of the amount paid according to the instructions set out below. The request must be made by email to the Language Centre Secretary's Office: contactocdi@uv.es

In general, it is established:

- If the Student cannot start the module due to force majeure, they may request a refund of the enrolment fee up to two days before the start of the module.
- Once the classes of the module enrolled in have started, requests to refund the enrolment fee will not be accepted.

Refunds due to visa refusal

If students need some kind of visa for their studies and it has been refused and they are unable to begin their programme of studies, they may request cancellation due to force majeure.

Instructions for requesting the refund of the amounts paid:

1. The student must send the request for cancellation and refund of the amounts paid within a maximum period of 30 days from the date of receiving the communication from the Embassy or Consulate.
2. The student must communicate in writing to secretariacdi@uv.es the cancellation due to visa refusal and attach the official document of refusal, dated, signed and stamped, issued by the Spanish Embassy or Consulate. The official refusal document must clearly state the student's name, passport number and the type of visa requested.

3. If the student appeals and the visa is denied again, the CDIUV will reimburse the full amount of the course, except for the pre-registration fees.



4. If the student does not join the selected course after having received a study visa justified by one of our programmes, no reimbursement will be made and the foreigners' authorities who issued the study visa will be informed of the situation.
